5. The Board should at all times include persons with skills in personnel, the nominating process, fundraising, philosophy and strategy, group process and/or organizational development.
6. Willingness to familiarize oneself as a board member with the ongoing program and business of WFP Upper Midwest.
7. Commitment to the long-term development of WFP Upper Midwest.
